Tamarack is a four-season resort located on Cascade Lake in Donnelly, Idaho.

Project Scope:

TORF Environmental Management was retained to develop petroleum spill prevention and emergency procedures plan (SPCC) for the golf and ski resort. The Client requested a Plan that would guide Resort staff and construction contractors in preventing and responding to oil and chemical spills.

Challenges: The resort was rapidly growing, with new facilities, new petroleum storage systems, multiple contractors and changing topography. A useful SPCC Plan requires flexibility but quick, clear instructions for emergency communication, response and cleanup.

Work Product: TEM authored a comprehensive SPCC Plan that describes chemical and oil storage systems, practices that can prevent spills, direction for when to notify regulatory authorities, how respond to mitigate spills, and actions to protect environmental resources if an accident happens.
